

[IRAS News] Set up your 2FA and get ready for Mandatory e-Filing!



1. SingPass 2FA to login to [myTax Portal](#) and [EASY](#)

From 5 Jul 2016, you will need your SingPass 2-Step Verification (2FA) to access all government e-Services, including IRAS e-Services at www.mytax.iras.gov.sg. Without 2FA, you will not be able to e-file:

- GST returns
- PIC Cash Payout applications
- Estimated Chargeable Income (ECI) and corporate tax returns (Form C – S / C)

So set up your SingPass 2FA now to avoid the last minute rush! If you have misplaced your PIN mailer, you may need to wait up to 7 working days for a new one to activate your 2FA.

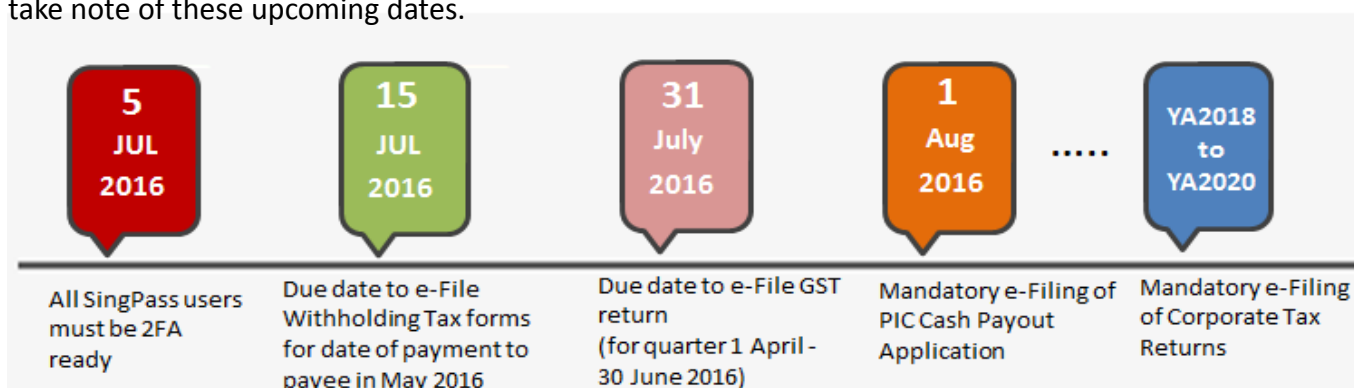

2. Get ready for mandatory e-Filing!

In line with Government's direction for more cost effective delivery of public services and the Smart Nation vision to harness technology to enhance productivity, e-Filing will be mandatory for more filing requirements. With e-Filing, all businesses can benefit from reduced compliance costs and productivity gains while enjoying the convenience of going paperless.
