

Dear Members,

SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES (SMMs) AT WORKPLACES

With effect from 5 April 2021,

- * Employees up to 75% from the current 50% may return to workplace at one time and that there is no restriction on the duration spent at the workplace;
- * Split teams are no longer mandatory;
- * Social activities will be allowed but remain not more than 8 persons;
- * No change to the current SMMs on physical work-related events, such as townhalls and seminars which remain capped at 50 persons.

Safe Management Measures (SMMs) at Workplaces

With effect from 5 April 2021

More employees may return to the workplace. Employers are still strongly encouraged to support as many employees to work from home as possible.

- Up to 75 per cent of staff can return to the workplace at any one time.
- No restriction on the duration spent at the workplace.
- Implement flexible working hours where possible.
- Split teams are no longer mandatory.

Social activities, such as team bonding, will be allowed, but limited to a group of no more than eight persons.

- Multiple groups of eight persons are not permitted.
- No change to the current SMMs on physical work-related events, such as townhalls and workplan seminars, which remain capped at 50 persons.

MTI MINISTRY OF TRADE AND INDUSTRY SINGAPORE

With effect from 24 April 2021, businesses can apply to the Singapore Tourism Board (STB) to organise the following pilot events:

- (i) Larger B2B events of up to 750 attendees, with pre-event testing (PET) for all attendees; the cohort size of 50 pax per zone applies.
- (ii) B2B events of up to 250 attendees, without PET; the cohort size of 50 pax per zone applies.
- (iii) Event Organisers (EOs) of approved B2B events can also increase the cohort size to 50 pax per zone, up from 20.

From 24 April 2021, the following selected activities will also be allowed to scale up further if they implement PET for their attendees.

- * The respective safe management measures for each activity or sector, as well as the safe capacities for each venue, continue to apply (please refer to summary annex below);
- * Individuals who have completed the full vaccination regimen and have had time to develop sufficient protection (i.e. two weeks after the second dose of the Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccination) can gain entry to events that implement pre-event testing without the need to undergo PET.

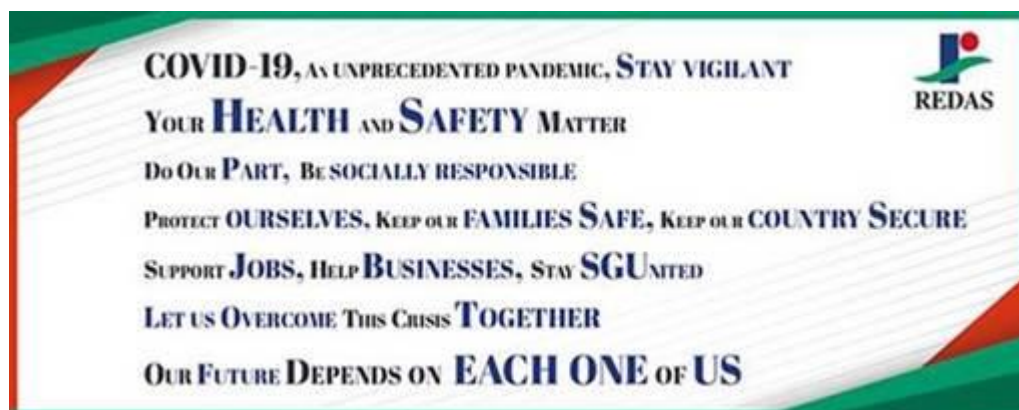

	101-250	Pre-event testing required only for bride and groom (if unvaccinated)	Pre-event testing required for all unvaccinated attendees
